Dear Parents:

This letter is to notify you of the opportunities that are being made available to your student under the new College Credit Plus legislation. This plan will be in effect during the 2015-2016 school year. College Credit Plus (CCP) will take the place of the Post-Secondary Education Options program. This new program includes the Dual Enrollment courses that are offered at Waterford High School. These courses are considered to be an advanced standing program under CCP.

These opportunities are available to any student in grades 7-12 who meets the admissions requirement set forth by the College or University that is offering the credit. Students must meet the admissions guidelines set forth by the college. These guidelines will be the same for all students, traditional and non-traditional, who apply. Students who plan to participate at Waterford High School in the Dual Enrollment courses will also have to meet these guidelines.

There are currently several courses that are offered at WHS. There will be additional courses added in the future as teachers are dedicated to furthering their education to provide opportunities for the students. Part of the CCP guidelines also state the each public high school will develop a 15 and 30 semester hour pathway for the students to complete earning dual enrollment credits. We are well on our way to having these available.

There will be a meeting for both parents and students to obtain additional information on March 17, 2015 at 6:00pm in the High School Band Room.
